- 4) Owls only eat other **animals** like mice, rats and even rabbits!
- 5) Owls can't **chew** their food, so they have to swallow it **whole**. The bad bits are coughed up as a **pellet**.
- 6) Owls can **fly** using their big wings. They don't make any noise because their **feathers** are so soft!
- 7) Not all owls **hoot** like a tawny owl. Barn owls make a funny **screeching** sound: "Screee!"
- 8) Owls have **four** toes. Their claws are called **talons**.
