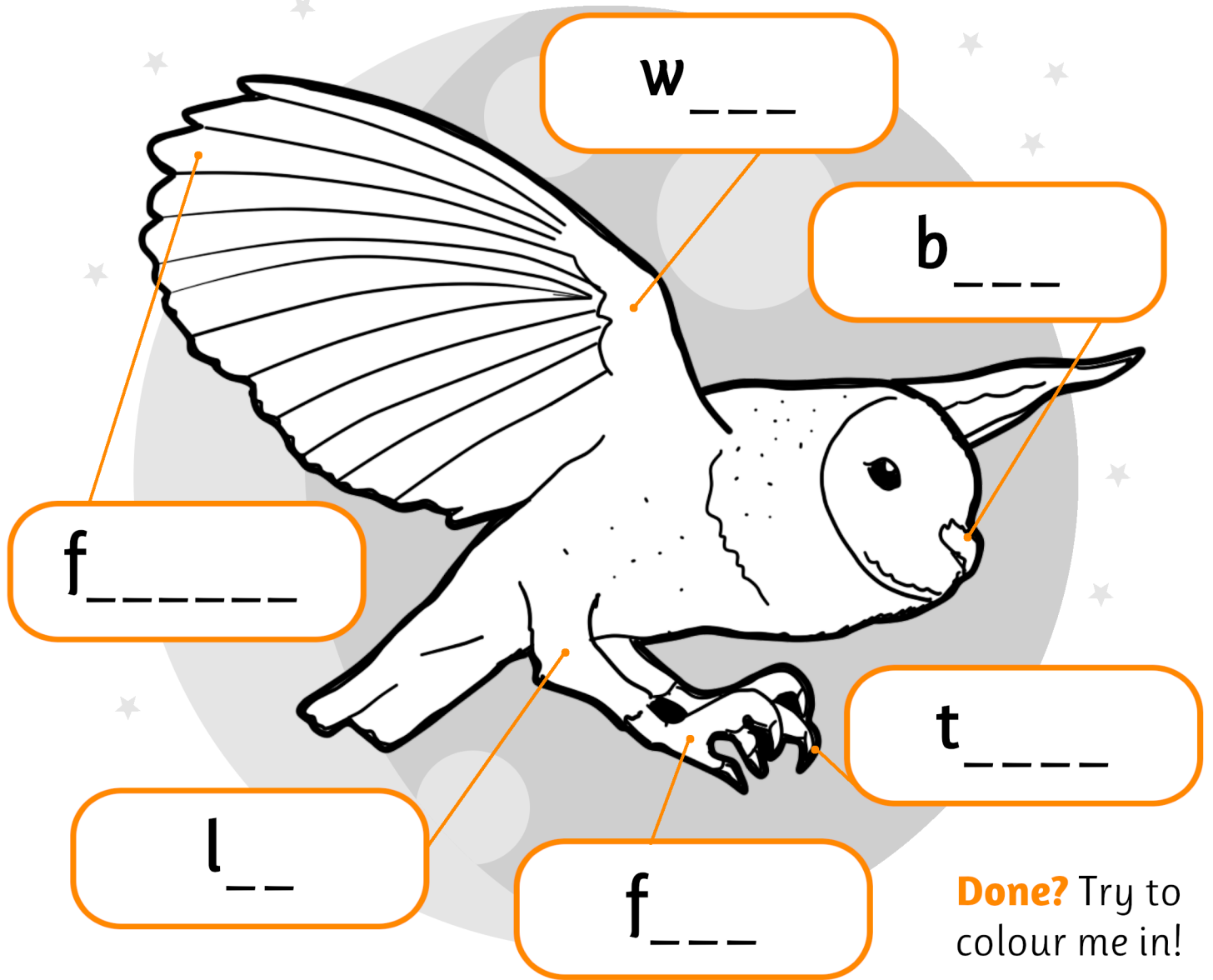


Parts of an owl

Complete the labels below to identify the parts of the owl shown in the picture. The first letters have been filled in for you.

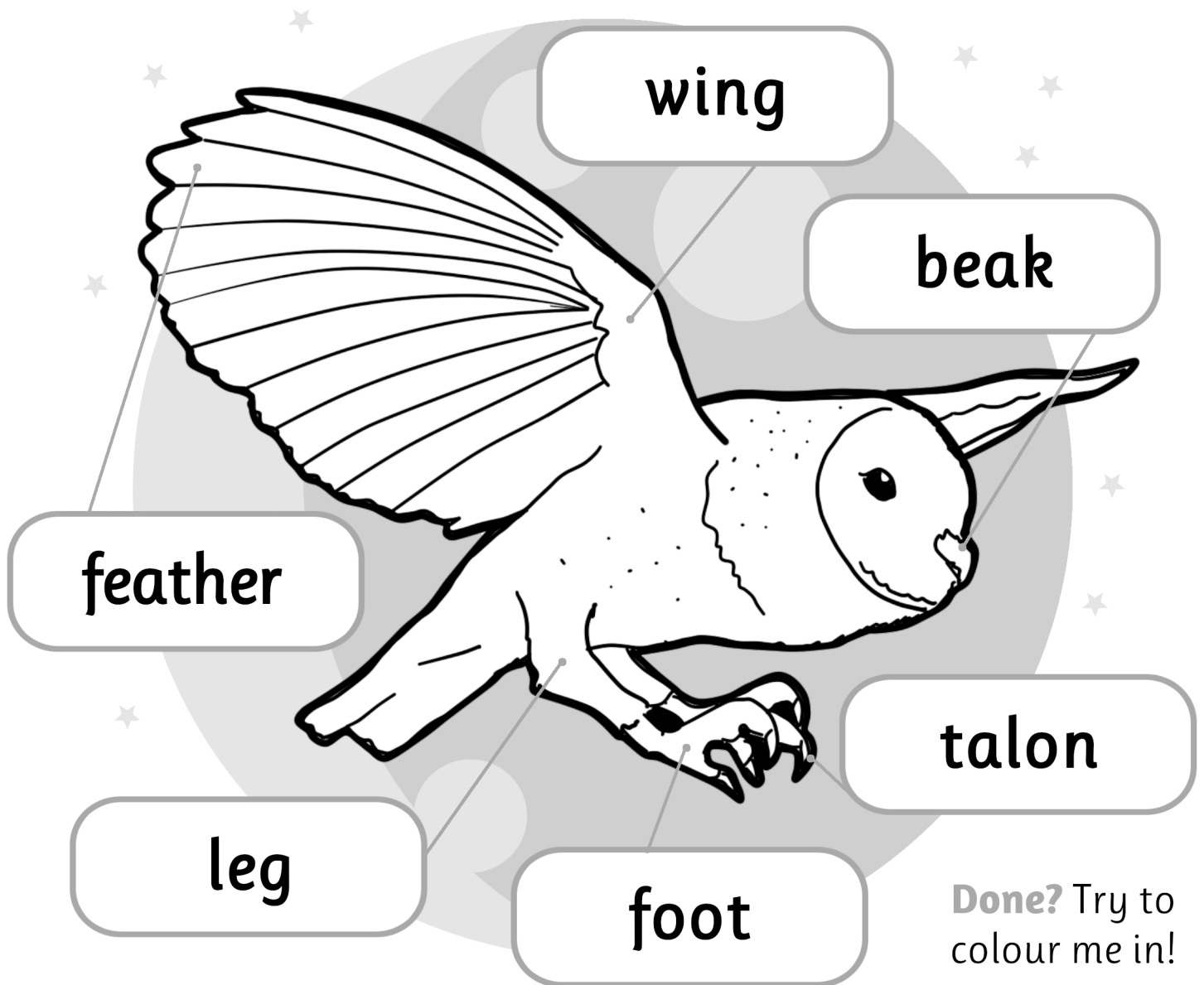
